COVID vaccines offered for families, children, individuals

COVID vaccines for residents, District 153 school families and kids are being offered from 3 to 6 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 7, at James Hart School, 18220 Morgan Ave. in Homewood. Vaccines are safe, effective and free for all regardless of insurance and immigration status, according to school officials. Children as young as age 5 are now eligible for the vaccine.

This program will provide first and second doses of the COVID-19 shots, booster shots and pediatric doses. A parent must be present for children ages 5 to 17 to receive the shot.
